Albert City Threshermen and Collectors Show Antique Tractor Pull Rules

- 1. Tractor models which started production 1960 or newer can pull but will be exhibition ONLY.
- 2. Class will be 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500, 7000, 7500, 8500, 9500 10500, and 11500
- 3. There will be a drivers meeting prior to the start of the tractor pull. All drivers are required to attend. After the meeting you must be lined up and ready to go.
- 4. No first pull repulls unless sled operator requests.
- 5. No weight allowance.
- 6. Tractors will be scored by distance pulled.
- 7. Entry fee of \$20.00 per hook. There will be a late fee of \$25 once registration closes. If adding weight classes during the pull it will be \$25 per hook.
- 8. Tractors can pull only once in each weight class but can be in as many classes as they want as long as they make weight.
- 9. Draw bars 20" maximum height and 18" minimum from the center of the rear axle to the point of hookup on the drawbar. Drawbar must have a ¾" pin or nut and bolt for 3" stationary clevis. If using a drawbar loop material must be between ¾" and 1.25" thick with a minimum of 3.75" diameter hole.
- 10. Tractor tires cannot be more than 18" off the ground while pulling. Flagman will stop any tractor if it is being operated in an unsafe manner.
- 11. Wheelie Bars are required in Open along with a working kill switch
- 12. Tractors must be in neutral while hooking to and from the sled.
- 13. Termination of pull pull stops when tractor stops forward motion or if any part of the tractor goes out of bounds. No jumping or jerking. The official's decision is final.
- 14. Repulls may be granted if the driver stops within 75 ft of the starting line.
- 15. Tractor drivers cannot be under the influence or consume alcoholic beverages during the tractor pull.
- 16. Drivers must remain on the tractor seat and have at least one hand on the steering wheel at all times.
- 17. Tractor must run stock RPM's. Excessive speeds will be disqualified by flagman or judges 3.5 mph in stock and 14 mph in open
- 18. Drivers must be at least 18 years old due to insurance purposes.
- 19. Stock Classes-No duals, shaved tires, or cut tires. No oversized rims, no hot rods, no turbos and absolutely no fuel mixtures will be allowed.
- **20. JUDGES DECISIONS ON ANY AND ALL MATTERS ARE FINAL.** All rules will be interpreted by the rules committee. The committee will rule on any unforeseen problems or oversights with their rulings being final. If tractor or puller are disqualified there will be no refund of said disqualifying hook.
